 - A secondary mechanical float will be added to assure no high level alarm condition
 - During and after an extreme rainfall, high level in the wet well caused a backup in a home on Elizabeth St.
 - Faulkner and DPW along with outside contractor and Village insurance company resolved issue with home owner
 - Boy Scouts : New grills in the park plus two new benches
 - With 8 inches of rain in October, DPW monitoring lift stations regularly
 - Discussion re: the Villages 2 large belly plow vehicles
