Need to ask village for approval on \$3200 (rest of village Parks and Recreation fund for 2018) to go towards Southwest Michigan planning commission Paw Paw river water trail clean up contract . This would help the SMPC in maintenance of the Paw Paw river segment in Lawrence; 48th ave to North County Line Rd.
