ITEMS OF DISCUSSION

- Water Ordinance
 - Due to the numerous ramifications implied and derived by the verbiage contained within the ordinance coupled with the complex integration of State and Federal regulations while embracing the needs of the Village, the PSC cannot at this time bring a viable draft to Council. Further work shall continue within this committee to complete the ordinance as expeditiously as possible.
 - Public hearing on this matter must be postponed.
- Managers report offered by Faulkner
 - Items of interest
 - We shall endeavor to post for public review (e.g. Web site) various water quality reports performed by Faulkner (water operator of record) and Johnson (discharge operator of record) that ultimately are submitted to the State (EGLE) and or retained by the Village.
 - The ongoing concern regarding traffic and congestion in front of the school during hours of operation.
 - DPW staff, the Village Manager, and the Village of Paw Paw (speed radar) are continuing to work with school officials to find a method to mitigate this situation.
- DPW report offered by Johnson.
 - We did have to inspect one of the sewage pumps at the new main lift station.
 - A foreign object of NO consequence was rubbing on the impeller making a noise. Had that object made it into the pump proper it would have been masticated and pumped to the lagoons with no problem.
