

AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE III

DIVISION 3. - VILLAGE MANAGER

Sec. 2-78. - Establishment of office.

In accordance with the authority for the appointment of such officers as the Council shall deem necessary for the execution of the powers granted to the Village contained in Section 2 of Chapter II and Section 8 of Chapter V of Public Act No. 3 as amended, the Office of Village Manager.

Sec. 2-79. - Appointment of Village Manager.

The Village Manager shall be appointed by the Village Council by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Council. The Village Manager serves at the pleasure of the Council and may be removed by a majority vote of the Council without cause, unless otherwise provided in an employment contract. The council may, at its discretion, enter into an employment contract with Village Manager for a period extending beyond the terms of the members of Council but not exceeding four years. An employment contract with a manager shall be in writing and shall specify the compensation to be paid to the manager, any procedure for changing compensation, any benefits and any other conditions of employment. The contract shall state that the manager serves at the pleasure of the council. The contract may provide for a severance pay or other benefits in the event the employment of the manager is terminated by the council. The manager shall serve at the pleasure of the council and may be removed by a majority vote of the council.

Sec. 2-80. - Acting Village Manager.

The president, with concurrence of a majority of the trustees, shall appoint or designate an acting manager during a vacancy in the office and shall make a permanent appointment within 180 days from the effective date of the vacancy.

No elected official of the village shall be appointed to the position of Village Manager within two years from the termination of the appointed office.

During temporary absence or disability of the Village Manager, the council, in lieu of appointing an acting village manager, may temporarily delegate the village manager's duties to another administrative office of the village.

Sec. 2-81. - Compensation.

The Village Manager shall receive such compensation as the Council shall determine annually by resolution or contract.

Sec. 2-82. - Responsibilities, functions and duties.

The Village Manager shall perform the duties as defined in the job description for Village Manager as approved by the Village Council.

Sec. 2-83. - Oversight.

No member of council shall attempt to influence the employment of any person by the village manager or in any way interfere in the management of departments under the jurisdiction of the manager. Except for purpose of inquiry, members of the council shall deal with employees and departments under the jurisdiction of the village manager through the manager.

Sec. 2-84. - Severability.

If any portion of this division or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be found to be invalid by a court, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of the application, provided that such remaining portions or applications are not determined by said court to be inoperable, and to this end, this ordinance is declared to be severable.

Sec. 2-86. - Certification.
